Occupational Therapy

The word 'Occupation' is associated with work. A child's occupation is learning through play, and some children need to be taught the skill 'to play' in order to learn their basic functional skills. Children need to learn many skills to develop age appropriate tasks and become successful in adulthood. The Occupational Therapist's role is to assess, plan and carry out intervention and to support parents to help develop and improve the child's wellbeing. OT Services Includes: **Activities of Daily Living | Gross Motor Development | Fine Motor Development | Sensory Processing | Visual Perception | Play** etc.

Cerebral Visual Impairment (CVI)

Cerebral Visual impairment CVI is a disorder caused by damage to the parts of the brain that process vision. It's most common in babies and young children, but can continue into adulthood. CVI is caused by an injury to the brain. Most of the time, these injuries happen before, during, or shortly after birth. Vision rehabilitation can help people with CVI make the most of their vision, babies and kids with CVI need Early Intervention and therapy, educational support, and other special services to help them develop and learn.

"Skill-Me" A tailored program (Early Intervention and Learning program (EILP))

Nupal CDC offers a unique, individually tailored Program that caters to children with special therapy needs, developmental delays and/or learning difficulties within a small group setting. This program can be an alternative for children gets benefit in a therapeutic setting and can't be catered for effectively within a mainstream nursery or preschool.

Speech Therapy

Language and communication needs. Communication is an essential component for learning and concerns are often first raised when children start nursery/school. Your child's teacher may have noticed that you child is not speaking, their speech is not fluent or is unclear, they may have difficulty understanding and following instructions or might display frustration because they might be struggling to communicate their needs. We work with a range of children including (but not limited to): **Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Cerebral Palsy (CB), Down's Syndrome (DS), Williams Syndrome, Cleft Lip and Palate, Sensory Processing Disorder, Developmental Language Disorder (DLD)** previously known as Specific Language Impairment, Brain Injury, Cognitive Delays and Disorders and Auditory Processing Disorder.

Special Education

We at Nupal CDC provide Special education service till the age of 10 years, We run Individualized Education Programs (IEPs) for students in need of specialized instruction, We ensures that a continuum of services are available to meet the needs of all students with disabilities.
